Classic Grace Worship at 8:00am on Sundays features the organ, hymns, choir, and liturgy from the Lutheran Service Book (LSB). From June 20 thru August 15, Holy Communion will be offered at all 8:00am services.

Majestic Praise Worship at 10:00am is led by a praise choir with piano and instrumentalists. Holy Communion is available on the 2nd, 4th, & 5th Sundays at this service. This service returns to 10:45a on Sunday, August 22, 2010.

During the **Summer Schedule** First will continue it's Sunday Coffee Fellowship Time after the early service and at 9:15am invites it's members to "Ology Times." These sessions introduce ways to serve our Lord and His church. Each week a different area is highlighted (i.e., Usherology, Greeterology). Nursery Care for children age 5 and under is provided during the **Sunday 10:00am service** in the Nursery located on the upper level in Room 210. Children are encouraged to be present in worship, but there may be a time when this ministry would be especially helpful. Children's worship bags are available in the lobby for use during the services – blue for younger children / maroon for older children.

Lutheran Christians believe that in the Sacrament of Holy Communion, the body and blood of Jesus Christ are received with the bread and wine for the forgiveness of sins and strengthening of our faith. Christians, who affirm that Jesus is their personal Savior and Lord, believe that they are sinful and without the hope of eternal life except for God's mercy in Christ, and desire to live a new life in Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit, are invited to celebrate this Sacrament with us. For those who choose not to receive wine, white grape juice is available in the center of the communion tray.

Sunday School and Adult Bible Studies Resume August 22 at 9:25am



Our Sunday School curriculum comes from Concordia Publishing House for our 3-year olds through 5th grade and is called "Growing in Christ." In the Fall the children study Old Testament stories/lessons leading up to Christmas, the Christmas story in December, and in January follow the life of Christ and New Testament stories/lessons about Jesus' ministry up until his death and resurrection. Following Easter the lessons focus on the spread of the Gospel message throughout the world. All the children gather together in our sanctuary each week (from Rally Day, August 22, thru the end of the school year) at 9:26 for a brief Sunday School opening before going to their classes. Students entering 6th through 7th grade are in our Confirmation Class. There are also classes for post confirmation and senior high

students. After August 22 we will again offer Sunday Adult Bible Studies beginning at 9:25am. A list of topics will be published as we get closer to Rally Day.
